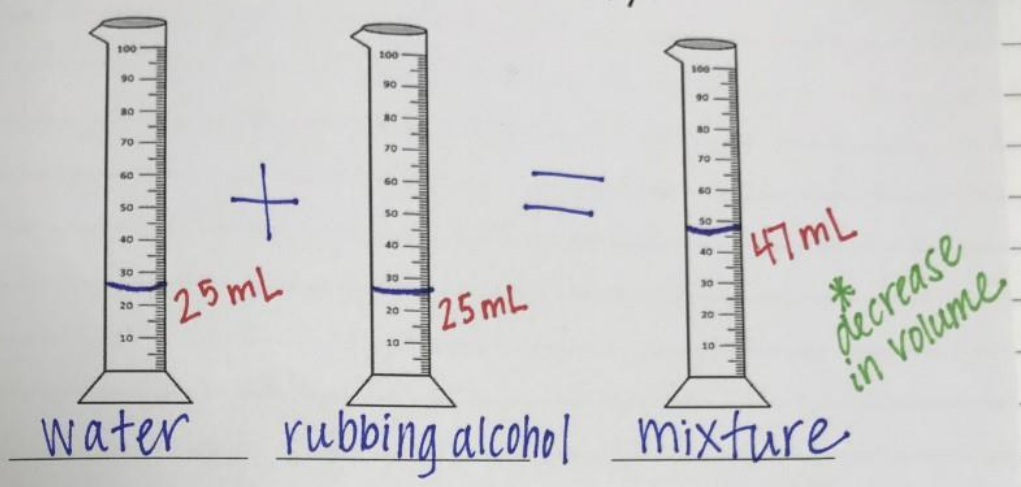


### Activity 3.2 Summary
